MOTORCYCLE OPERATOR SAFETY TRAINING INSTRUCTOR CANDIDATE AGREEMENT

I acknowledge that complete and successful achievement of all curriculum provider training and state program criteria are required to become a recognized CO MOST Instructor.

PRE-INSTRUCTOR TRAINING

Submission of the curriculum provider (TCT) Instructor / (MSF) RiderCoach training application

Submission of a recent (within 30-days) Colorado driver record with a minimum of 3 years history.

*If less than 3-year Colorado license history, then past out-of-state license record is required.

Acknowledgment that a deposit of \$150 may be collected by your Vendor. Which may be returned upon successful completion of all Instructor Training and program certification requirements.

BASIC COURSE and APPRENTICESHIP

Successful completion of a Basic Course, as required by curriculum provider, within one (1) year of start of Instructor Candidate training.

Apprenticeship of a complete Basic Course accomplished prior to Instructor Candidate training. (As familiarization of Instructor role, responsibilities, and physical obligations during a course.)
Apprentice may help with non-instructional duties, such as range set-up, demos, etc.

Of note:

If either the Basic Course and/or Apprenticeship are not completed prior to Instructor Training, then the candidate will be disqualified from training and not allowed to participate.

POST-INSTRUCTOR TRAINING (INTERNSHIP)

After graduation of curriculum provider training, completion of two (2) successful Mentorship Courses as Provisional MOST Instructor under supervision of a MOST Instructor within 90 days.

After graduation of curriculum training, completion of the Diversity and Harassment eCourse within 90 days.
